Q4 - Roosevelt Lake - Sunday October 6th, 2024

Apache Lake - 17 boats launching out of Burnt Corral.  
Roosevelt Lake - 17 boats launching out of Cholla.

For both events, please be on the water by 5:45am. National Anthem will be at approximately 5:50am. Blast Off immediately after. Be there at least an hour before to check in to meet your partner and get live-wells checked.

Please be sure to have your live wells checked by a member of the AZBN board.

\*\*\*Designated Off Limits Areas\*\*\*

Please see attached photos of the off limit areas.

Also off limits, any area posted NO FISHING or NO ENTRY or NO MOTORIZED ENTRY.

No part of the boat may enter the off limit areas.

You ARE allowed to cast into the off limit areas.

At Roosevelt Lake, anglers can fish the outside of the marina tires but not go into the marina.

## 2 FLIGHTS:

Boats 1-10: Due in at 3:00PM

Boats 11-17: Due in at 3:15PM

\*\*\*Weigh-in scales will not be open until approximately 3:20pm.\*\*\*

\*\*\*Please DO NOT bag your fish and/or bring to the scales until the scales are open.\*\*\*

Non-Boaters - Remember to bring your own life jacket, food, drinks, and money to help with gas/oil expenses.

Reminder Read the Rules posted on the website:

Here are a few to note.

- 12" Minimum - Mouth Closed Tail Pinched
- Big fish must be tagged to weigh for big fish.
- Nets are allowed
- A-Rigs, Double Flukes, Double Rigs, baits with more than two wires - Not Allowed
